JOB DESCRIPTION: MWW is working to improve women's reproductive health by reducing deaths in pregnancy and childbirth in West Wollega, Ethiopia, We are achieving this through a systematic and evidence based safe motherhood project.

Gimbie Hospital was established as an NGO hospital in 1947. It serves a population of half a million people. The number of births in the hospital has increased significantly to 1500/year since MWW became responsible for the obstetric service and started the village based safe motherhood initiative. The majority of the births are complicated (eclampsia, severe preeclampsia, ruptured uterus, maternal deaths, stillbirths, severe haemorrhages, craniotomies and obstetric fistula). MWW employ an Ethiopian obstetrician. As a short-term obstetrician you will aid the maternity team daily with training and the running of the hospital based component of the safe motherhood project in Gimbie
